

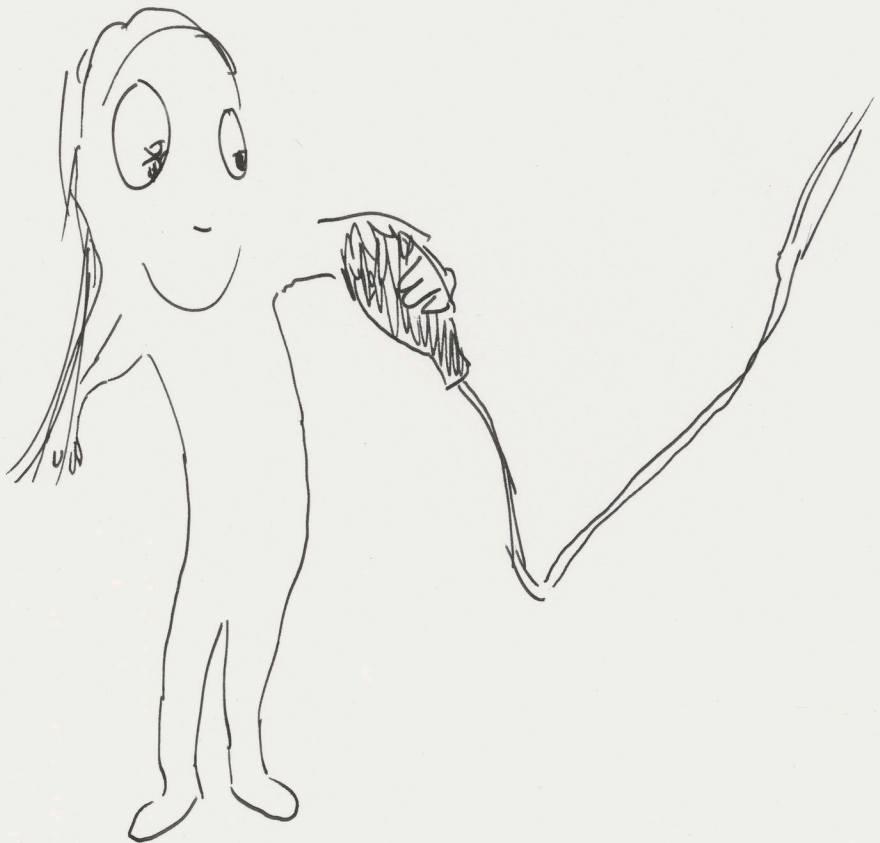

Take a bottle of chocolate syrup and make a trail leading from the celebrant's location to the party room



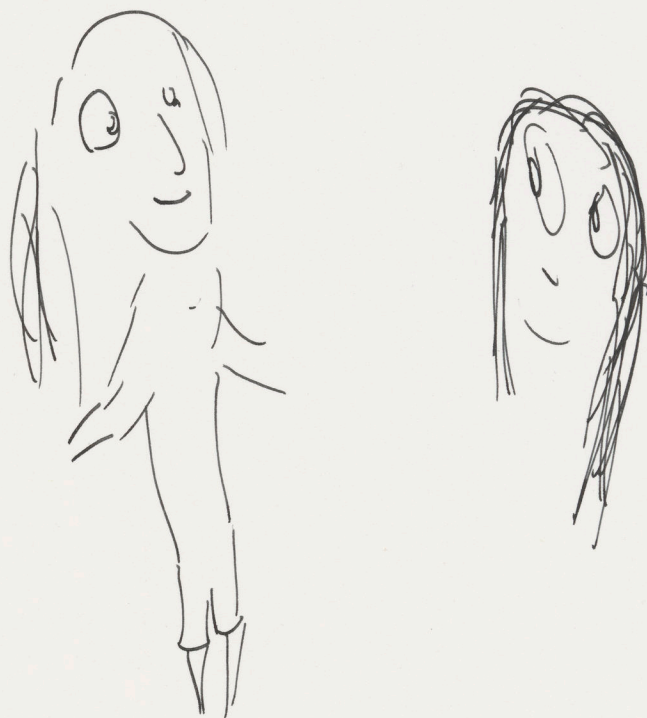
Walk around with a boombox playing party music then stand in front of them just grooving, being wavy with your knees.
